Sample Course Sequence

In order to complete the program in 5 years, students may select one of the following options after consulting with their advisor to determine the best course:

- A. Students may take 3 of their graduate courses during their 4th year. In order to make up the additional 3 undergraduate course units, students will have to either overload in a semester (with a minimum GPA of 3.3) and take the credits during summer and winter terms in addition to any AP credits student have transferred in.
- B. Student may opt to take 3 graduate courses in the summer between years 4 and 5.
